



## Nentico Lodge Event Participant Code of Conduct

1. Adhere to the Scouting America Guide to Safe Scouting, including all Safeguarding Youth Protection, driving to and from events, and buddy system policies. Safety begins before, during, and after every event.
2. Wear the proper and complete official Scouting America uniform when required, particularly during travel, ceremonies, meals, and meetings. Event T-shirts and casual attire may be worn at other times as directed by event leadership.
3. Keep all areas clean, handle equipment responsibly, and report any damage immediately. I will be responsible for any damages or loss I cause.
4. Attend all required program sessions, ceremonies, and activities on the event schedule unless excused by event staff. Follow the event schedule, and observe quiet hours and lights-out as designated.
5. Be properly registered and paid for each event and occupy only the assigned sleeping area. No unregistered guests are permitted.
6. The possession or use of alcohol, illegal drugs, or non-prescribed controlled substances is strictly prohibited. The use of tobacco, e-cigarettes, or vaping devices is not permitted at youth events and must follow Scouting America policy at adult events.
7. Do not leave camp or the event site without permission from the event's adult leadership. Park only in designated areas and follow all instructions from staff regarding driving and unloading. Only authorized vehicles may operate within camp during an event.

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I understand that failure to follow this Code of Conduct may result in disciplinary action, including removal from the event, removal from lodge leadership positions, suspension of membership privileges in Nentico Lodge, or further action by the Baltimore Area Council.
